"AN ACT REVISING CERTAIN ABSENTEE VOTING ELIGIBILITY STATUTES." "

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subsections (a) to (c), inclusive, of section 9-150a of the
4 general statutes are repealed and the following is substituted in lieu
5 thereof (*Effective from passage*):

6 (a) [The] On the day of an election, primary or referendum, the
7 absentee ballot counters shall proceed to the central counting location
8 or to the respective polling places when counting is to take place
9 pursuant to subsection (b) of section 9-147a at the times designated by
10 the registrars of voters.

11 (b) At the time each group of ballots is delivered on the day of an
12 election, primary or referendum to [them] the absentee ballot counters
13 pursuant to section 9-140c, the counters shall perform any checking of
14 such ballots required by subsection (i) of said section and shall then

15 proceed as hereinafter provided.

16 (c) Except with respect to ballots marked "Rejected" pursuant to
17 section 9-140c or other applicable law and not earlier than the day of the
18 election, primary or referendum, the counters shall remove the inner
19 envelopes from the outer envelopes, shall note the total number of
20 absentee ballots received and shall report such total to the moderator.
21 [They] The counters shall similarly note and separately so report the
22 total numbers of presidential ballots and overseas ballots received
23 pursuant to sections 9-158a to 9-158m, inclusive."
