"AN ACT CONCERNING HEATING EFFICIENCY IN NEW CONSTRUCTION AND MAJOR ALTERATIONS OF RESIDENTIAL BUILDINGS."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2022*) For purposes of this
4 section, "agency" and "regulation" have the same meanings as provided
5 in section 4-166 of the general statutes, and "public funds" means any
6 funds belonging to, or under the control of, the state or a political
7 subdivision of the state. On and after October 1, 2022, any regulation
8 proposed by any agency of the state that requires the expenditure of any
9 public funds, except for regulations regarding codes and standards
10 adopted pursuant to chapter 541 of the general statutes, shall be fully
11 funded by the state or a political subdivision thereof upon the adoption
12 of such regulation. If any such regulation is not fully funded upon
13 adoption, or ceases to be funded after adoption, the regulation shall be

14 deemed permissive and not mandatory.

15 Sec. 502. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2022*) For purposes of this section,
 16 "municipality" means any town, city, borough, consolidated town and
 17 city or consolidated town and borough, and "public funds" means any
 18 funds belonging to, or under the control of, the state or a political
 19 subdivision of the state. On and after October 1, 2022, any ordinance
 20 proposed by any municipality that would require the expenditure of
 21 any public funds shall be fully funded by the state, a political
 22 subdivision of the state or the municipality upon adoption of such
 23 ordinance. If any such ordinance is not fully funded upon adoption, or
 24 ceases to be funded after adoption, the ordinance shall be deemed
 25 permissive and not mandatory."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
