**"AN ACT CONCERNING AN ANALYSIS OF THE AVENUES TO
MAXIMIZE THE VALUE OF CERTAIN STATE-OWNED REAL
PROPERTY."**

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) (a) There is established a working
4 group to identify ways to increase profitability from the current
5 operations of Hartford Brainard Airport and the businesses located at
6 said airport, including by reviewing operations at other comparable
7 small and medium-sized airports. The working group shall consist of
8 the following members:

9 (1) One appointed by the speaker of the House of Representatives,
10 who shall be a representative of the Connecticut Airport Authority,
11 established pursuant to section 15-120bb of the general statutes;

12 (2) One appointed by the president pro tempore of the Senate, who
13 shall be a representative of Hartford Brainard Airport;

14 (3) One appointed by the majority leader of the House of
15 Representatives, who shall be a representative of the Capital Region
16 Development Authority created pursuant to section 32-601 of the
17 general statutes;

18 (4) One appointed by the majority leader of the Senate, who shall be
19 a representative of the Hartford board of education;

20 (5) One appointed by the minority leader of the House of
21 Representatives, who shall be a representative of an aviation technical
22 school located at Hartford Brainard Airport; and

23 (6) One appointed by the minority leader of the Senate, who shall be
24 a representative of an entity or organization that makes use of the
25 airport facility.

26 (b) All initial appointments to the working group shall be made not
27 later than thirty days after the effective date of this section. Any vacancy
28 shall be filled by the appointing authority.

29 (c) The speaker of the House of Representatives and the president pro
30 tempore of the Senate shall select the chairpersons of the working group
31 from among the members of the working group. Such chairpersons shall
32 schedule the first meeting of the working group, which shall be held not
33 later than sixty days after the effective date of this section.

34 (d) The administrative staff of the joint standing committee of the
35 General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to finance,
36 revenue and bonding shall serve as administrative staff of the working
37 group.

38 (e) Not later than January 1, 2023, the working group shall submit a
39 report on its findings and recommendations to the joint standing
40 committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters
41 relating to finance, revenue and bonding, in accordance with the
42 provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes. The working group
43 shall terminate on the date that it submits such report or January 1, 2023,

44 whichever is later."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:		
Section 1	<i>from passage</i>	New section
