**"AN ACT CONCERNING AN ANALYSIS OF THE AVENUES TO
MAXIMIZE THE VALUE OF CERTAIN STATE-OWNED REAL
PROPERTY."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (*Effective from passage*) (a) The cochairpersons and ranking
4 members of the joint standing committee of the General Assembly
5 having cognizance of matters relating to commerce shall convene a
6 working group to investigate ways to expand aviation mechanic
7 educational opportunities at Hartford Brainard Airport through formal
8 and informal partnerships with regional technical-community colleges
9 and other institutions of higher education.

10 (b) In addition to the cochairpersons and ranking members of said
11 committee, the speaker of the House of Representatives, the president
12 pro tempore of the Senate, the majority leader of the House of
13 Representatives, the majority leader of the Senate, the minority leader
14 of the House of Representatives and the minority leader of the Senate

15 shall each appoint one member to the working group. Each appointed
 16 member shall be a representative of the aviation industry, an aviation-
 17 related industry, a regional technical-community college or other
 18 institution of higher education, Hartford Brainard Airport or the
 19 Connecticut Airport Authority.

20 (c) All initial appointments to the working group shall be made not
 21 later than thirty days after the effective date of this section. Any vacancy
 22 shall be filled by the appointing authority.

23 (d) The speaker of the House of Representatives and the president
 24 pro tempore of the Senate shall select the chairpersons of the working
 25 group from among the members of the working group. Such
 26 chairpersons shall schedule the first meeting of the working group,
 27 which shall be held not later than sixty days after the effective date of
 28 this section.

29 (e) The administrative staff of the joint standing committee of the
 30 General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to commerce
 31 shall serve as administrative staff of the working group.

32 (f) Not later than January 1, 2023, the working group shall submit a
 33 report on its findings and recommendations to the joint standing
 34 committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters
 35 relating to commerce, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a
 36 of the general statutes. The working group shall terminate on the date
 37 that it submits such report or January 1, 2023, whichever is later."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
