**"AN ACT IMPLEMENTING THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE
AUDITORS OF PUBLIC ACCOUNTS."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2022*) Any person who has been
4 issued an operator's license with a public passenger endorsement to
5 operate a school bus or student transportation vehicle pursuant to
6 section 14-44 of the general statutes, as amended by this act, who is
7 employed by a local or regional board of education or contracts with
8 any entity to operate a school bus or student transportation vehicle in
9 the state and is arrested for a violation of section 14-227a or 14-227m of
10 the general statutes or subdivision (1) or (2) of subsection (a) of section
11 14-227n of the general statutes shall report such arrest to such person's
12 employer or the contracting entity not later than forty-eight hours after

13 such arrest."
