

# Occupational, Registration, Certification, and Licensing Requirements for Individuals

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## Issue

This report lists the occupations requiring a state registration, certification, or license for individuals and the general requirements for obtaining these credentials, including applicable (1) application or credential fees and (2) related education, experience, or exam requirements. This report updates OLR Report [2021-R-0214](#).

## Summary

This report divides the data into two categories. Table 1 lists the occupations that require only a fee to obtain the credential; Table 2 lists those that generally require paying fees along with meeting some educational, experience, or exam requirement (i.e., a skills- or knowledge-based test). Table entries are organized alphabetically by the agency with jurisdiction over the credential.

The report focuses on occupations that require a specific credential as a first step for an individual to practice the occupation, thus excluding those that require a credential after being hired (e.g., police). The report also generally excludes credential requirements (1) that are granted to businesses but could be given to individuals and (2) for entities such as manufacturers, wholesalers, or dealers.

Although the report highlights the skill and knowledge requirements an individual must meet to initially work in an occupation, there are occupations with (1) exceptions to the requirements, (2) requirements beyond those described in the tables, and (3) different credentialing requirements for out-of-state applicants. The report excludes these exemptions and requirements, including:

- circumstances under which an exam requirement may be waived for certain occupations, such as when an applicant has other credentials;
- additional requirements applicants may need to meet to be credentialed, such as submitting to a background check or fingerprinting, maintaining insurance or providing evidence of financial responsibility, submitting endorsement or reference letters, or being of a minimum age;
- separate requirements for applicants who are credentialed in another state (e.g., reciprocity) or receive their education at foreign institutions; and
- subsequent or ongoing requirements, such as renewal fees or continuing education.

In addition, the report excludes fees associated only with taking an exam as they may not be set out in law.

Lastly, given the scope of the request, please note that we made every effort to search the statutes and applicable regulations, but it is possible that there are requirements that our search inadvertently missed.
