HB 5232

AN ACT PROHIBITING PUBLIC INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION FROM RECEIVING MONEY FOR SOLICITING STUDENTS TO GAMBLE ONLINE.

SUMMARY

This bill prohibits public higher education institutions from profiting or receiving money from a sponsor, marketing company, or other entity for allowing it to directly solicit enrolled students to gamble through a website, online service, or mobile application. Under the bill, “directly solicit” means making direct contact with a person through mail, phone, e-mail, in-person communication, or any other means to induce the person to make a transaction.
