Substitute Senate Bill No. 950

Senate, March 28, 2023

The Committee on Commerce reported through SEN. HARTLEY of the 15th Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the Senate, that the substitute bill ought to pass.

***AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY OF MANUFACTURING,
WORKFORCE SHORTAGES AND TRAINING.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Commissioner of Economic and
2 Community Development shall conduct a study of manufacturing
3 issues in the state, including, but not limited to, workforce shortages and
4 training. Not later than January 1, 2024, the commissioner shall submit
5 a report on the results of such study to the joint standing committee of
6 the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to
7 commerce, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the
8 general statutes.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Section 1	<i>from passage</i>	New section
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Statement of Legislative Commissioners:

In the first sentence, "a study relating to" was changed to "a study of" for consistency with standard drafting conventions.
