Explanation

The bill, which allows 15-year-olds to work as youth camp staff members or lifeguards under specified circumstances and establishes an amusement establishment employment pilot program, does not result in any fiscal impact to the state or municipalities.

Senate "A" adds a supervision requirement under the bill's provisions and establishes an amusement establishment employment pilot program through August 27, 2023, which does not result in any fiscal impact.

House "A" exempts municipalities from the working paper requirement for lifeguards and youth camp staff, which does not result in any fiscal impact.
