AN ACT REQUIRING AN APPLICANT FOR A MOTOR VEHICLE OPERATOR LICENSE WHO IS SIXTEEN OR SEVENTEEN YEARS OF AGE TO COMPLETE A SAFETY COURSE ON THE EFFECTS AND IMPACT OF MARIJUANA.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That subsection (d) of section 14-36 of the general statutes be
- 2 amended to require that each applicant for a motor vehicle operator
- 3 license who is sixteen or seventeen years of age complete a course of not
- 4 less than four hours relative to the effects of marijuana and the impact
- 5 of marijuana on the operator of a motor vehicle.

Statement of Purpose:

To ensure teenage drivers are properly educated on the dangers of operating a motor vehicle while under the influence of marijuana.
