**AN ACT CONCERNING A CRIME VICTIM'S PARTICIPATORY RIGHTS
IN A VIOLATION OF PROBATION HEARING.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 53a-32 of the general statutes be amended to afford a
- 2 crime victim the same participatory rights in a hearing concerning a
- 3 violation of probation that he or she is afforded in a hearing concerning
- 4 early termination of probation pursuant to section 53a-29 of the general
- 5 statutes.

Statement of Purpose:

To ensure that a crime victim has participatory rights in any hearing concerning a violation of probation by the person who committed the criminal act.
