**AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY OF INCREASED ACCOUNTABILITY
AND COMPETITION IN THE ELECTRIC DISTRIBUTION AND
TRANSMISSION INDUSTRY.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That a task force be established to study (1) how the market serviced
- 2 by each electric distribution company may be reconstituted in order to
- 3 be more accountable to ratepayers and more responsive to ratepayer
- 4 needs, and (2) the introduction of competition in the electric
- 5 transmission or distribution services industry in the state. Such study
- 6 shall include, but need not be limited to, an evaluation concerning the
- 7 costs of acquiring electric transmission or distribution services
- 8 infrastructure from each electric distribution company.

Statement of Purpose:

To study the consumer benefit of increased accountability and competition in the electric distribution and transmission industry.
