AN ACT CONCERNING THE USE OF FUNDING FROM THE OPIOID SETTLEMENT FUND TO BE USED TO SUPPLY A PATIENT WHO HAS BEEN PRESCRIBED AN OPIOID DRUG WITH A PERSONAL-USE PHARMACEUTICAL DISPOSAL SYSTEM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require funding from the
- 2 Opioid Settlement Fund to be used to simultaneously supply a patient
- 3 receiving an opioid drug prescription with a personal-use
- 4 pharmaceutical disposal system without additional costs to the
- 5 dispensing pharmacy or the patient.

Statement of Purpose:

To require funding from the Opioid Settlement Fund to be used to simultaneously supply a patient receiving an opioid drug prescription with a personal-use pharmaceutical disposal system without additional costs to the dispensing pharmacy or the patient.
