**AN ACT CONCERNING CANCELLATION OR REVOCATION OF A  
POLICE OFFICER'S CERTIFICATION FOR UNDERMINING PUBLIC  
CONFIDENCE IN LAW ENFORCEMENT.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 7-294d of the general statutes be amended to specify the
- 2 circumstances under which the Police Officer Standards and Training
- 3 Council may cancel or revoke the certification of a police officer for
- 4 conduct that undermines public confidence in law enforcement.

To make clear the circumstances under which a police officer's certification may be cancelled or revoked.
