**AN ACT CONCERNING COLLEGE GRADUATES WHO WORK IN THE
FIELDS OF EDUCATION OR HEALTH CARE IN THE STATE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to establish a student loan
- 2 forgiveness program or public-private partnership with the goal of
- 3 encouraging graduates from institutions of higher education to pursue
- 4 careers in teaching or health care in the state.

Statement of Purpose:

To establish a student loan forgiveness program or public-private
partnership to encourage college graduates to pursue careers in
teaching or health care in the state for the purpose of addressing labor
shortages in such fields.
