**AN ACT CONCERNING THE INCLUSION OF FINANCIAL LITERACY
INSTRUCTION AS PART OF THE HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION
REQUIREMENTS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10-221a of the general statutes be amended to include as
- 2 part of the high school graduation requirements a course in financial
- 3 literacy, which may include, but not be limited to, banking, loans and
- 4 financing, credit, leases, investing, money management and retirement
- 5 planning, with exceptions provided for students with individualized
- 6 education plans.

Statement of Purpose:

To require all Connecticut high school students to complete a course in
financial literacy so that they will obtain broad financial literacy skills.
