AN ACT PROHIBITING THE DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION FROM MODIFYING A CONSENT ORDER WITHOUT THE AGREEMENT OF THE OTHER PARTIES TO SUCH AGREEMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to prohibit the Commissioner
- 2 of Energy and Environmental Protection, or the commissioner's
- 3 designee, from modifying or revoking a consent order without the
- 4 approval of the other parties to such consent order.

Statement of Purpose:

To ensure that any consent order entered into by a party and the Commissioner of Energy and Environmental Protection, or the commissioner's designee, is not modified or revoked without the consent of the parties affected by the order.
