**AN ACT CONCERNING ADEQUATE AND EQUITABLE STATE
FUNDING FOR NONPROFIT PROVIDERS OF HUMAN SERVICES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 4 of the general statutes be amended to (1) ensure that state
- 2 payments to nonprofit providers of human services are adequate by
- 3 indexing contracts and reimbursement rates to the value of the goods
- 4 and services they provide, and (2) provide annual cost-of-living
- 5 adjustments equal to the increase in expenses experienced by such
- 6 providers.

Statement of Purpose:

To make nonprofit human services providers whole, allow for predictability in their budgeting, recognize the services they provide and payment losses suffered during the pandemic, and ensure their future viability to serve state residents.
