AN ACT CONCERNING OPIOIDS AND INSURANCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 700c of the general statutes be amended to require
- 2 individual and group health insurance policies to provide health
- 3 insurance coverage, without prior authorization or a prescription, and
- 4 regardless of whether naloxone is available over the counter, for not less
- 5 than one generic opioid antagonist and device.
