**AN ACT CONCERNING THE NUMBER OF WAGE AND HOUR
INSPECTORS AT THE LABOR DEPARTMENT.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 558 of the general statutes be amended to require a
- 2 minimum of forty-five wage and hour inspectors be employed at the
- 3 Labor Department.

Statement of Purpose:

To increase the number of wage and hour inspectors at the Labor Department in order to monitor the increasing number of wage theft complaints in the state.
