**AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY REGARDING THE  
ESTABLISHMENT OF A FLEXIBLE SPENDING ACCOUNT PROGRAM  
FOR CHILD CARE EXPENSES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Comptroller shall conduct a  
2 study regarding the establishment of a flexible spending account  
3 program for residents of the state to use for costs incurred relating to  
4 child care. Such study shall include, but need not be limited to, the  
5 feasibility of administering such program in a manner similar to the  
6 dependent care spending account program for state employees  
7 established under sections 5-264b and 5-264c of the general statutes.  
8 The Comptroller shall submit such study, in accordance with the  
9 provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes, to the joint standing  
10 committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters  
11 relating to labor and public employees not later than January 1, 2024.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
