**AN ACT CONCERNING THE LICENSE RENEWAL FEE AND
SCHEDULE FOR LICENSED CLINICAL SOCIAL WORKERS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to (1) allow licensed clinical
- 2 social workers practicing pursuant to an initial license to practice for a
- 3 period of at least twelve months before having to apply for a renewal of
- 4 such license, (2) require that license renewals for licensed clinical social
- 5 workers occur on the birth month of the license holder, (3) increase the
- 6 licensure period for licensed clinical social workers to two years, and (4)
- 7 reduce the licensure fees for licensed clinical social workers employed
- 8 by nonprofit entities by fifty per cent.

Statement of Purpose:

To increase licensure periods for licensed clinical social workers and reduce licensure fees for licensed clinical social workers employed by nonprofit entities.
