**AN ACT REQUIRING THE USE OF OPIOID SETTLEMENT FUNDS TO
EQUIP MUNICIPAL POLICE OFFICERS WITH OPIOID ANTAGONISTS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require that a portion of
- 2 opioid settlement funds be used to equip municipal police officers with
- 3 opioid antagonists, such as Narcan, with a priority on supplying officers
- 4 in departments currently without access to Narcan.

Statement of Purpose:

To give municipal police officers the tools they need to provide for
public safety, save lives and combat the opioid epidemic.
