AN ACT PROTECTING PROPERTY OWNERS AGE FIFTY AND OLDER FROM FORECLOSURE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That chapter 205 of the general statutes be amended to (1) prohibit

2 any municipality from placing a lien for delinquent taxes on any real

3 property that is the principal residence of, or integral to a business

4 owned by, any property owner age fifty or older unless taxes owed on

5 such property exceed fifteen per cent of such property's assessed value;

6 (2) limit interest on delinquent taxes owed by any such property owner

7 on such real property to the annual rate of inflation as determined by

8 the National Consumer Price Index; (3) limit legal fees, penalties and

9 fees associated with the collection of such delinquent taxes from any

10 such property owner to not more than twenty per cent of taxes due at

11 the time of settlement; and (4) make it a class D felony punishable by up

12 to five years of incarceration or five thousand dollars in fines, or both,

13 for any municipal agent to violate any provision of subdivisions (1) to

14 (3), inclusive, of this act.
