**AN ACT CONCERNING THE OPERATION OF A MOTOR VEHICLE BY
A PERSON UNDER TWENTY-ONE YEARS OF AGE WHILE UNDER
THE INFLUENCE OF MARIJUANA.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 248 of the general statutes be amended to prohibit the
- 2 operation of a motor vehicle by a person who is less than twenty-one
- 3 years of age while having any trace of tetrahydrocannabinol or
- 4 cannabinoid metabolites in the blood or urine of such person at the time
- 5 of operation, as shown by a chemical analysis of such person's blood or
- 6 urine.

Statement of Purpose:

To adopt a zero-tolerance law that prohibits a person who is less than
twenty-one years of age from driving under the influence of marijuana.
