AN ACT CONCERNING THE DATE ON WHICH A CHILD MUST TURN FIVE YEARS OLD IN ORDER TO ENROLL IN KINDERGARTEN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10-15c of the general statutes be amended to require a
- 2 child to be five years of age by August first of the year such child enters
- 3 kindergarten.

Statement of Purpose:

To make Connecticut more consistent with other states and to improve academic outcomes by requiring students to have reached age five by August first of the year they enter kindergarten.
