AN ACT CONCERNING A REVIEW OF THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE STATE-WIDE MASTERY EXAMINATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That title 10 of the general statutes be amended to require the
2 Department of Education to (1) (A) conduct an audit of the costs and
3 time spent by boards of education to administer the state-wide mastery
4 examination, including a summary of costs to the state, (B) apply for
5 available funding under the Every Student Succeeds Act or other federal
6 programs to conduct such audit, and (C) develop and submit
7 recommendations for streamlining the administration of the state-wide
8 mastery examination; (2) produce an assessment reduction plan; (3)
9 create the Collaborative on Education Assessment and Innovation led
10 by education practitioners to study and report on education
11 performance assessment based on the two pillars of (A) student
12 performance assessments, and (B) school quality measures; and (4)
13 organize and implement a pilot program to carry out a model of the
14 findings of the Collaborative on Education Assessment with a
15 consortium of various sized school districts.

Statement of Purpose:

To reduce the amount of time spent preparing for and administering the state-wide mastery examination and to address the cost effectiveness of standardized assessments.
