***AN ACT CONCERNING NONPARTISANSHIP OF STATE ELECTIONS
ENFORCEMENT COMMISSION STAFF.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

1 That section 9-7a of the general statutes be amended to further
2 prohibit staff of the State Elections Enforcement Commission from (1)
3 making political contributions, (2) organizing a political organization,
4 (3) directly or indirectly soliciting, handling or accounting for funds
5 used for political purposes, including fundraising, (4) participating in
6 campaign activities, such as soliciting votes or acting as a challenger at
7 or driving electors to polling places, (5) publicly giving a political
8 endorsement, however publicized, (6) participating in a political party
9 convention or addressing such a convention, caucus, rally or similar
10 gathering, (7) circulating a nominating petition, and (8) displaying
11 political paraphernalia.

Statement of Purpose:

To prohibit State Elections Enforcement Commission staff from
engaging in partisan political activity.
