**AN ACT CONCERNING THE AUTHORITY OF A POLICE OFFICER TO

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to allow a police officer to take
- 2 a person into protective custody and transport such person to an
- 3 emergency room or a substance abuse facility if the officer has
- 4 administered an opioid antagonist to such person or taken other
- 5 lifesaving measures.
