**AN ACT CONCERNING THE DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC AND
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND INFRASTRUCTURE
IMPROVEMENT.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Commissioner of Economic and
2 Community Development shall conduct a study relating to
3 infrastructure improvement issues in the state, including, but not
4 limited to, encouraging brownfield projects and downtown
5 revitalization ventures. Not later than January 1, 2024, the commissioner
6 shall submit a report on the results of such study to the joint standing
7 committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters
8 relating to commerce, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a
9 of the general statutes.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following
sections:
