AN ACT ESTABLISHING AN ELECTRONIC LIEN AND TITLE PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) Not later than July 1, 2024,
2 the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles shall establish and administer an
3 electronic lien and title program that requires the electronic recording
4 and releasing of vehicle title information for new, transferred and
5 corrected certificates of title. Lienholders shall electronically transmit
6 liens and the release of a lien to the commissioner, in such form and
7 manner as prescribed by the commissioner. The commissioner may
8 enter into an agreement with one or more qualified independent
9 contractors to implement the electronic lien and title program.

10 Sec. 2. (*Effective from passage*) On or before February 1, 2024, the
11 Commissioner of Motor Vehicles shall submit a report, in accordance
12 with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes, to the joint
13 standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of
14 matters relating to transportation regarding the status of the
15 implementation of the electronic lien and title program and any

16 recommendations for legislation and funding necessary to implement
17 such program.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Statement of Purpose:

To require the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles to establish and administer an electronic lien and title program.
