AN ACT CONCERNING AGING AND PERSONS WITH INTELLECTUAL AND DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Commissioner of Aging and
2 Disability Services shall study the higher prevalence of Alzheimer's
3 disease, dementia, and other related disorders in persons with
4 intellectual and developmental disabilities and determine whether
5 state programs adequately address such higher prevalence. Not later
6 than February 1, 2024, the commissioner shall report, in accordance
7 with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes, on such
8 study to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having
9 cognizance of matters relating to aging.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
