AN ACT CONCERNING THE MOBILE NARCOTIC TREATMENT PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) Not later than October 1, 2023, the
2 Commissioner of Mental Health and Addiction Services, in
3 consultation with the Commissioners of Public Health, Social Services
4 and Consumer Protection, shall report, in accordance with the
5 provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes, to the joint standing
6 committees of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters
7 relating to appropriations and the budgets of state agencies, public
8 health, human services and general law on (1) the activities of the
9 Mobile Narcotic Treatment Program, as defined in 21 CFR 1300, in the
10 state over the past year, including the geographic areas and
11 populations served, (2) the anticipated services to be provided under
12 said program in the next year, (3) the impact to the community, (4) the
13 effectiveness of such services, (5) recommendations for changes and
14 improvements to the program, and (6) an estimate of state funding
15 needed to provide effective mobile narcotic treatment program
16 services throughout the state.
