**AN ACT PROHIBITING CERTAIN HEALTH CARRIERS FROM
REQUIRING STEP THERAPY FOR PRESCRIPTION DRUGS
PRESCRIBED TO TREAT BEHAVIORAL HEALTH CONDITIONS OR
CHRONIC, DISABLING OR LIFE-THREATENING CONDITIONS OR
DISEASES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That sections 38a-510 and 38a-544 of the general statutes be amended
- 2 to prohibit certain health carriers from requiring the use of step therapy
- 3 for prescription drugs prescribed to treat behavioral health conditions
- 4 or chronic, disabling or life-threatening conditions or diseases.

Statement of Purpose:

To prohibit certain health carriers from requiring the use of step therapy for prescription drugs prescribed to treat behavioral health conditions or chronic, disabling or life-threatening conditions or diseases.
