***AN ACT CONCERNING COMPENSATION FOR CERTAIN EMPLOYEES
WHOSE SCHEDULED SHIFT HAS BEEN REDUCED OR CANCELLED.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 557 of the general statutes be amended to require that
- 2 any employer with a least five hundred employees, within the United
- 3 States or globally, pay certain retail and hospitality employees half of
- 4 their regular pay rate for any scheduled hours that the employer cancels
- 5 or reduces either (1) after such employee reports to work for the
- 6 scheduled hours, or (2) less than seven days in advance of such
- 7 scheduled hours.

Statement of Purpose:

To require certain employers to provide advance notice to certain employees of changes in such employees' work schedules.
