**AN ACT CONCERNING ACCOUNTABILITY FOR THE EXPENDITURE
OF FEDERAL CORONAVIRUS RELIEF FUNDS RECEIVED BY THE
STATE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require (1) the chief executive
- 2 officer of each municipality receiving federal funds related to COVID-
- 3 19 relief to submit a report to the Secretary of the Office of Policy and
- 4 Management that includes a full accounting of the municipality's
- 5 expenditure of such funds and post the report on the municipality's
- 6 Internet web site, and (2) the secretary to submit a report to the joint
- 7 standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of
- 8 matters relating to appropriations and the budgets of state agencies of
- 9 such federal funds and to post the report on said office's Internet web
- 10 site.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide transparency, oversight and accountability for the state's
expenditure of certain federal funds.
