**AN ACT CONCERNING DEVELOPMENT OF AN ALTERNATIVE
PATHWAYS PROGRAM FOR HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 556 of the general statutes be amended to require the
- 2 Labor Commissioner to develop a program that identifies high school
- 3 graduates who are not attending college or working in a trade within
- 4 six months of graduation and provides such graduates with information
- 5 regarding alternative career pathways available in the state.
