AN ACT REQUIRING PHARMACISTS TO INFORM PATIENTS AND HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS REGARDING THE LEAST EXPENSIVE MEDICATION OPTION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require pharmacists to
- 2 inform each patient and the patient's prescribing practitioner regarding
- 3 the least expensive option for a medication or class of medicine that has
- 4 been prescribed by the prescribing practitioner and the out-of-pocket
- 5 cost of such medication or class of medicine if purchased without
- 6 insurance.

Statement of Purpose:

To require pharmacists to inform each patient and the patient's prescribing practitioner regarding the least expensive option for a medication or class of medicine that has been prescribed by the prescribing practitioner and the out-of-pocket cost of such medication or class of medicine if purchased without insurance.
