***AN ACT CONCERNING THE DISPLAY OF THE DECLARATION OF
INDEPENDENCE AND THE CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES
FOR STUDENTS IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS THROUGHOUT THE STATE.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10-230 of the general statutes be amended to require local
- 2 and regional boards of education to display a copy of the Declaration of
- 3 Independence and the Constitution of the United States in a
- 4 conspicuous location, visible to all students, in each school under the
- 5 jurisdiction of such board, and that title 10 of the general statutes be
- 6 amended to provide funding to any board of education that does not
- 7 have the resources to display a copy of the Declaration of Independence
- 8 and the Constitution of the United States for its students.

Statement of Purpose:

To ensure that students are able to learn about the foundation of the rights and liberties of all citizens of the United States of America.
