**AN ACT CONCERNING REQUIREMENTS AND PATHWAYS FOR
STATE EMPLOYMENT.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 67 of the general statutes be amended to require the
- 2 Commissioner of Administrative Services to (1) where practicable,
- 3 eliminate requirements for college degrees for appointment to state
- 4 classified service, (2) provide pathways with alternative routes for
- 5 appointment to state classified service for applicants, and (3) report
- 6 progress back to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly
- 7 having cognizance of matters relating to labor and public employees by
- 8 February 1, 2024.

To increase the applicant pool for state employment.
