**AN ACT ESTABLISHING IMMUNITY FROM LIABILITY FOR
PHYSICIANS AND OTHER HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS WHO ARE
UNABLE TO SEE A REFERRED PATIENT.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to establish immunity from
- 2 liability for a physician or health care provider when a referred patient
- 3 is unable to be seen by the physician or health care provider in cases
- 4 involving preprocedure evaluation, discharge care and medication
- 5 plans.

Statement of Purpose:

To establish immunity from liability for physicians and other health care providers who are unable to see referred patients.
