AN ACT ALLOWING CERTAIN OUT-OF-STATE HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS TO PROVIDE TELEHEALTH SERVICES IN THE STATE ON A PERMANENT BASIS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to implement, on a permanent
- 2 basis, the provisions of public act 21-9 that (1) allow certain out-of-state
- 3 health care providers to provide telehealth services in the state for a
- 4 limited duration, and (2) require coverage of such services by such
- 5 providers by certain health insurance policies for a limited duration.

Statement of Purpose:

To permanently allow the provision of telehealth services by certain outof-state health care providers.
