AN ACT CONCERNING AMENDMENTS TO THE STATE BUILDING CODE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 29-252b of the general statutes be amended to require
- 2 that any proposed amendment to the State Building Code be
- 3 accompanied by a statement that describes the financial impact of such
- 4 amendment on consumers and the building trades and professions, and
- 5 to require a two-thirds vote of each chamber of the General Assembly
- 6 for adoption of such amendment.

Statement of Purpose:

To require a financial impact statement for any proposed amendment to the State Building Code and a two-thirds vote by the General Assembly for adoption of any such amendment.
