AN ACT ELIMINATING THE QUALIFYING INCOME THRESHOLDS FOR THE PERSONAL INCOME TAX DEDUCTION FOR SOCIAL SECURITY BENEFITS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 12-701 of the general statutes be amended to eliminate
- 2 the qualifying income thresholds for the personal income tax deduction
- 3 for Social Security benefits.
