**AN ACT CONCERNING SUPERMARKETS AND THE HIRING OF  
INDIVIDUALS AT LEAST SIXTEEN YEARS OF AGE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 557 of the general statutes be amended to authorize
- 2 individuals who are at least sixteen years of age to be employed in
- 3 positions at supermarkets that are currently limited to persons over the
- 4 age of eighteen, provided that such individual receives the appropriate
- 5 training and supervision for such position.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To allow supermarkets to employ individuals who are at least sixteen years of age in positions currently limited to individuals over eighteen years of age.
