***AN ACT CONCERNING COST-BASED REIMBURSEMENT FOR
FEDERALLY QUALIFIED HEALTH CENTERS.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subsection (e) of section 17b-245d of the general statutes is
2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1,*
3 *2023*):

4 (e) The department [may] shall adjust a federally qualified health
5 center's encounter rate based upon [an increase or decrease in the scope
6 of services] the average of cost reports for the previous two years
7 furnished by the federally qualified health center [, in accordance with
8 42 USC 1396a(bb)(3)(B), following receipt of the written notification
9 described in subsection (c) of this section or based upon the
10 department's review of documents filed in accordance with subsections
11 (a) and (b) of this section.] to the department, in accordance with
12 subsection (a) of this section.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Section 1	July 1, 2023	17b-245d(e)
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Statement of Purpose:

To require that Medicaid reimbursement for federally qualified health centers be based on costs incurred by such health centers.
