AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY OF PATHWAYS TO STATE EMPLOYMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Commissioner of Administrative
2 Services shall conduct a study regarding the hiring practices by state
3 agencies for positions in state service. Such study shall include, but need
4 not be limited to, (1) the feasibility of eliminating requirements for
5 college degrees for certain appointments to state classified services, and
6 (2) the feasibility of establishing a program to provide applicants with
7 pathways with alternative routes for appointment to state classified
8 service. Not later than January 1, 2024, the commissioner shall submit a
9 report with the findings of such study, in accordance with the provisions
10 of section 11-4a of the general statutes, to the joint standing committee
11 of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to labor
12 and public employees.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
