AN ACT CONCERNING ENERGY GENERATED FROM SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 22a-228 of the general statutes is amended by
2 adding subsection (f) as follows (*Effective from passage*):

3 (NEW) (f) On or before January 1, 2024, the Commissioner of Energy
4 and Environmental Protection shall revise the state-wide solid waste
5 management plan to incorporate the findings and implement the
6 recommendations contained in the report issued by the Public Utilities
7 Regulatory Authority in Docket No. 22-10-07. Such revised state-wide
8 solid waste management plan shall include planning and policy
9 recommendations for contract-enabling legislation to provide a stable
10 energy value for trash-to-energy facilities, for incentives to retain
11 existing trash-to-energy facilities or incentivize the construction of new
12 such facilities, and for a procurement plan to select a trash-to-energy
13 facility project.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:		
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Section 1	<i>from passage</i>	22a-228(f)
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Statement of Purpose:

To require the state's solid waste management plan to implement the findings of the Public Utilities Regulatory Authority's report on trash-to-energy.
