Title: AN ACT CONCERNING UTILITY CUSTOMER PAYMENT PLANS, EXTENDING THE SHUTOFF MORATORIUM FOR HARDSHIP CUSTOMERS AND PERMITTING HARDSHIP CUSTOMERS TO ENROLL WITH ELECTRIC SUPPLIERS.

Statement of Purpose: To (1) permit the Public Utilities Regulatory Authority to authorize utility customer amortization agreements of up to thirty-six months or longer, (2) permit the authority to make grants to legal organizations and attorneys that assist customers with enrolling in utility-sponsored bill payment programs, and (3) extend the shutoff moratorium for hardship customers of gas and electric companies.
