**Title:** AN ACT CONCERNING RIDESHARE AND DELIVERY DRIVER MINIMUM STANDARDS.

**Statement of Purpose:** To establish reciprocity with neighboring states in order to allow Connecticut drivers to pick up passengers in such states and to require network companies to, (1) provide network workers with minimum pay per trip, (2) provide trip receipts to both workers and passengers, and (3) pay for other fees incurred during trips.
